WCM Riding/Driving Lesson Options:

A La Carte Professional Horse Training Sessions \$40

- Professional training constitutes specific plan designed by Valarie Siemer, WCM Trainer
- After 3 incidences of short/no notice, the time slot will be forfeited

Standard Individual Private/Semi-private Riding/Driving Lesson = \$45 per student

Additional Individual Group Riding Lesson = \$40 per student

- 12 week personalized Academy Lesson Program commitment required
- Prepayment, one month in advance, required
- 24 hour rescheduling required, for makeup lesson
- Less than 24 hour notice of cancellation, no refunds or makeup, unless excused absence
- After 3 incidences of short/no notice, the time slot will be forfeited for duration of 12 weeks, and must reapply for alternate day/time

WCM Board, Training, and Medical Recovery Options:

Stall Security Deposit for all horses required = \$700 (one month's board)

- *Premium Full Board & Full Training \$1000*
- Horse professionally trained 4 or more days
- 3 advanced rider/driver lessons with Valarie, per week - no charge
- When Valarie is attending a show, lessons may be rescheduled with another WCM instructor or forfeited
- Lessons with other WCM instructor - \$20 per lesson
- Horse/rider teams eligible for WCM A-Circuit show string
- Blacksmith credit/billing available through WCM and reimbursed with monthly board
- Medical/surgical recovery and special needs are included

Standard Full Board & Full Training \$900

- Horse professionally trained 4 or more days
- Two (2) advanced rider/driver lesson with Valarie per week - no charge
- When Valarie is attending a show, lessons may be rescheduled with another WCM instructor or forfeited
- Lessons with other WCM instructor - \$20 per lesson
- Horse/rider teams eligible for WCM A-Circuit show string
- Blacksmith bills must be prepaid, checks left at WCM each 6 weeks
- Medical/surgical recovery and special needs are included

Full Board, Partial Training \$850

- Horse professionally worked two (2) times per week
- Horse/rider teams not eligible for WCM show string
- Lessons are not included
- Blacksmith bills must be prepaid, checks left at WCM each 6 weeks
- Medical/surgical recovery and special needs are not included

Full Board, no Training \$700

WCM Show Fees:

All show bills must be paid at least one week of scheduled departure date

A-Rated and Non-Academy Show rates:

Day Fee \$70 per day off the farm for all shows, except the Grand Nationals

Day Fee \$100 per day off the farm for the Grand Nationals

The day fees cover all training and grooming (i.e., bathing, clipping, and other related preparations) expenses for the duration of the show.

Clients are charged individually, per horse, for the following:

- Office fees and entries
- Shavings
- Hauling
- Braiding, based on type and number of times per show needed
- Body clipping \$130

Clients split the following services based on the number of horses attending the show:

- Shared Stalls
- Use of equipment
- Sponsorships and advertising
- WCM Staff travel expenses

(Estimated) Round Trip Hauling for 2010, prices subject to change without advanced notice

- Florida State Fairgrounds (Charity Shows, Harvest Days) \$100 per horse
- Ocala Livestock Pavilion (Summer's End) \$225 per horse
- Canterbury Equestrian (Citrus Cup) \$300 per horse
- Raleigh & Asheville, North Carolina, Lexington, VA (Old Dominion, Mid-A) \$1300 per horse
- Oklahoma City, OK (Grand Nationals) \$2600 per horse

Tipping guidelines for the full-time grooms, part-time grooms get less accordingly

- Florida State Fairgrounds (Charity Shows, Harvest Days) \$10 per class, per person
- Ocala Livestock Pavilion (Summer's End) \$15 per class, per person
- Canterbury Equestrian (Citrus Cup) \$50-75 per person
- Raleigh & Asheville, North Carolina (Southern States, Blue Ridge) \$50-70 per person
- Lexington, VA (Old Dominion, Mid-A) \$50-70 per person
- Oklahoma City, OK (Grand Nationals) \$125-150 per person

Academy Show rates: (includes all expenses except tipping grooms)

Tipping guidelines: \$15-30 for the day, and all tips are split amongst the grooms

- Academy one day shows at the Fairgrounds \$350 (\$375 for two classes)
- Academy one day farm shows \$300 (\$325 for two classes)
- Academy one day farm shows at WCM \$250 (\$275 for two classes)

WCM Private Birthday Parties

WCM offers kids and adults an opportunity to have an exceptional 3 hour horse experience including riding, horse education, games, arts & crafts. Similar to WCM Horse Camp, each student will have their own instructor and given a mini-lesson, based on their individual abilities. WCM Trainer Clinic

WCM offers a fantastic learning experience to spend 2 hours with our trainers riding/driving and then reviewing video with focused discussion on each individuals strengths and points of improvement. The individualized, enhanced training experience will further develop and polish each student's skills. Dates will be scheduled at least 30 days in advance for riding and driving clinics.

- Open to Academy and A-Circuit riders, with each student's instructor consent
- Limited to 1-4 students, with each student's instructor consent
- Riders ride in group environment with all instructors present in the ring
- Family or friend must video and bring compatible cable to watch in client lounge following the ride
- Riding portion is 30 minutes
- Personal instructor review will be 30 minutes per rider, with limited group discussion
- Clinics only offered at WCM on Sunday afternoons, once every 12 weeks
- \$50 per student
- Clinics will be scheduled for intermediate and advanced groups of similar skill level

WCM Advanced Rider Jumping Experience

For those with a burning desire to learn some of the basics of jumping. We can provide the start-up skills needed to consider purchasing an over-fences Morgan. Eligible riders will approved at WCM consent based on specific criteria and skill set.

- Private only, with limited availability
- Ground poles and finding distances will be the primary focus, followed by design and way of going
- For a more formal jumping process, students must purchase their own Morgan to proceed to higher venues
- \$60 per student
- Not included as part of standard Academy Lesson Program schedule
